Choosing your wedding decor can be overwhelming, especially when many suppliers offer the same mass-produced items. If you're dreaming of something unique, I'm here to help with a collection of bespoke, handmade pieces that will bring your vision to life. My goal is to simplify the process by offering a curated range of decor, centrepieces & bouquets that complements each other perfectly—no need to juggle multiple suppliers. And if you choose my on-the-day coordination service, I'll take care of everything, so you can relax and enjoy your day.

I'm passionate about sustainability, which is why I create high-quality, reusable decor that looks as if it's come straight from the forest. By using artificial and dried foliage and flowers, my pieces are designed to be used again and again. I also strive for a minimalist lifestyle, prioritising time with my daughter and working on a limited number of weddings each year. I charge a minimum spend of £600 per booking, ensuring I drive less miles delivering and setting up weddings in order to reach the modest financial goal I set myself per year. Richness in time is my aim, as well as my eventual goal to live off-grid and be self sufficient.

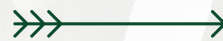

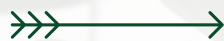

Packages

There are three ways to get more from your styling, with less stress:

My Fern Package includes all your decor and centrepieces. The Bloom Package builds on this with bridal and bridesmaid bouquets, plus buttonholes/pocketsquares. If you're looking for full peace of mind, the Meadow Package includes everything from Bloom, along with on-the-day coordination to keep things running smoothly.

There's a minimum spend of £800 for couples who are just looking for a few key pieces of decor for their day. Mileage is extra, with the first 15 miles from DL16 included, unless you book one of my packages below and the radius is included to 40 miles. Full set up and take down is included in all my quotes and packages.



The flowers in my bouquets are carefully dried or preserved at their peak, meaning they hold their shape and colour long after your wedding day, becoming a lasting keepsake of your celebration rather than something binned the next morning.

Each bouquet is thoughtfully crafted to complement the seasons and my decor collection, with a small, curated range of designs to choose from. This considered approach means your bouquet arrives beautifully in sync with your overall styling – without the overwhelm of endless options.

I work with British growers and sustainably conscious suppliers wherever possible, choosing stems with a lower environmental footprint and a gentler journey to your hands. This slower, seasonal approach means your bouquet not only looks beautiful – it feels aligned with your values too.

By ordering your bouquet through me, there's no need to coordinate with another florist or juggle another supplier. It's one less thing on your to-do list, and one more element of your day styled with care, intention, and cohesiveness.

Bouquets are only available to my Bloom or Meadow Package couples or as an add on to couples with a minimum spend of £1000 on their decor. Additional bridesmaid bouquets are £90 and buttonholes/pocketsquares are £15

Sylvie

Rooted in the wildness of nature, Sylvie, meaning 'from the forest', embodies the heart of my brand. A fresh take on green-on-green styling, Sylvie is full of layered textures and soft movement. Designed with a variety of ferns and natural foliage, it brings depth and structure without ever feeling too formal. The preserved white roses add contrast, subtle but striking, and give the bouquet a clean, classic feel.

Ideal for modern couples drawn to natural tones and a little bit of wild, Sylvie works beautifully with my core styling pieces.

I’ll step in a month before your wedding to take over venue and supplier communication, smoothing out any last-minute details and ensuring everything aligns perfectly. You can relax, knowing that those final few weeks before your wedding will be stress-free and filled with excitement, not admin. On your wedding day, I’ll be there for up to 10 hours, orchestrating every detail behind the scenes. From setup to tear-down, I’ll keep the day running seamlessly so you can fully immerse yourself in celebrating with your loved ones.

Natural Love Lights

The Essential Wedding Decor Item

My natural love lights are the item that kickstarted Feather and Fern Event Hire back in 2019 when they were first displayed at Ikea's Valentine's Day event! At the time, love lights were very much an in your face item, they were bright, bold and usually white. I wanted to offer a more neutral version which would compliment the type of venues I love to work at rather than stand out. They're made of a type of plywood I specifically chose for the grain, making these equally as beautiful during the day rather than just being an item waiting for the sun to go down. Being battery powered they can also be placed anywhere in your venue as well as being easily moved throughout the day.

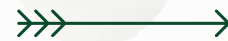

Centrepieces

let me take care of it all...

I've created a range of centrepieces that work well across different venues and setups, all designed to feel considered but relaxed, nothing overdone or fussy.

I use a mix of dried and preserved flowers, along with treated foliage, which means everything's real but built to last. It's a more sustainable approach (I can reuse pieces across weddings), but it can also give a more vibrant look than fresh flowers—lots of texture, movement, and warm tones that photograph really nicely.

As table styling is so bespoke to each wedding, after we've had a consultation I'll be able to give a quote based on the look you want to achieve. However if you book one of my packages, you're free to choose from any of my centrepiece designs as part of that. I'll help you pick the right fit based on your venue, layout, and overall style, there's no need to figure it all out on your own.

The photos below show a few examples of what I can offer, including classic vases and candles, trees, bud vases, Gaia vases, flower bars, wooden lanterns and plinths, concrete planters and troughs, disco balls as well as gold, black and various coloured glass tapered candle holders.



Chair Sashes

Whether it's romantic chiffon drops or classic bows, I have a range of fabrics and colours to choose from. Chair sashes are £3 per sash including set up, or if you book any of my packages you get the first 50 included.





How It Works

Contact me

Fill in the contact form on my website giving me as much detail as you can about your hopes for your decor. It may be as simple as wanting to hire a few items from me, or booking one of my packages



Quote, moodboard & securing your date

I'll reply personally within 48 hours to let you know my availability and we can start getting into the details of your day. If required, I will make a mood board to help bring your vision to life. Depending on your chosen package, a £100, £200 or £400 booking fee is required to secure your date (this is taken from the total cost for your decor)



Finalising Details

Check in

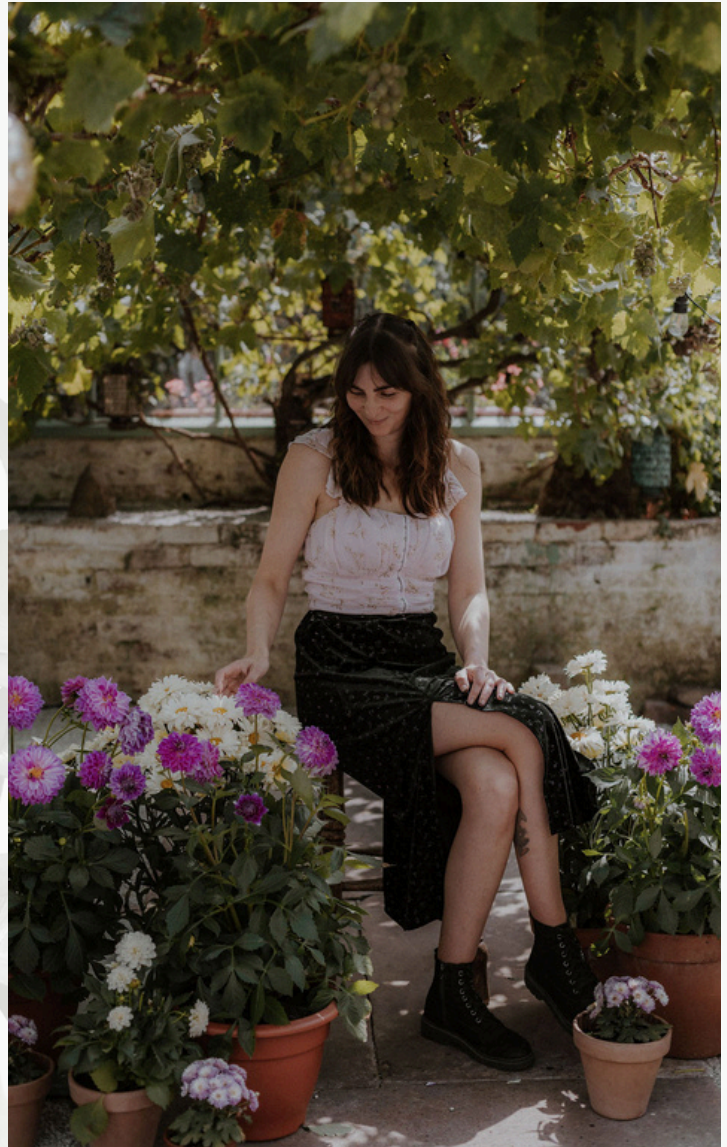
6 months prior to the wedding I'll get in touch to see how plans are progressing and check if there's any updates needed for your booking.

Pay the balance

3 months before the wedding your balance will be due. One month prior to this I'll send you a payment reminder.

Tell me everything

Once the balance is paid you'll be sent a link to my online form which allows you to tell me where you'd like all your chosen hire items to go in the venue, as well as other key information you'd like me to know about your day. This can be filled out any time before the wedding and ensures everything runs smoothly on the day. If you've opted for bouquets and centrepieces then this will be when we finalise the design.



Venue

Roughly one month before the wedding I'll contact your venue to make arrangements for set up

Final check in

2 weeks before the wedding I'll get in touch to confirm all the details with you. Everything will then be in place for your magical day!

On-The-Day Coordination

If you've opted for on-the-day coordination, your timeline will differ slightly to what's above. You'll be sent a personalised timeline if you've chosen this package.

FAQs + Terms & Conditions

- **How far do you travel?** I cover the whole of the North East, North Yorkshire and Scottish Borders. Mileage is charged at 45p per mile for two return trips beyond a 15-mile radius of DL16. If you've booked a package, this is extended to 40 miles of free delivery.
- **Do you have a minimum spend?** To ensure my clients receive first class service and to be as sustainable as I can, I only take on a certain amount of weddings per year. This means in order to be profitable I do charge a minimum spend of £800.
- **Can I place items outside?** Some of my items can be placed outside for ceremony or photo opportunities however it is the responsibility of the hirer that items are not damaged due to poor weather conditions. Items such as arches or large freestanding pieces may not be safe to use outdoors in high wind or unstable ground conditions. Final decision rests with me on the day (it's always helpful to have a plan B due to the British weather!). No items are to be left outside over night and in the event that the hirer or venue will not take responsibility to move items indoors then I will collect items on the night time once your celebrations have ended.
- **Are you insured?** I have full public liability insurance in place. In the event of Force Majeure (including but not limited to severe weather, pandemic restrictions, road closures, or illness), liability is limited to a full refund of all monies paid. I cannot be held responsible for any indirect losses incurred due to such circumstances.
- **What happens if anything gets damaged during the celebrations?** Items are hired to you the customer named on the booking form. The responsibility of ensuring my products are not damaged is part of the customer's agreement. If any damage is caused, then any charges relating to the repair or replacement would fall on the responsibility of the customer named on the invoices/receipts at the time of booking and an invoice will be sent accordingly. Damage includes (but is not limited to) breakage, staining, tearing, water damage, or misuse of any item, as well as any destruction to preserved or artificial foliage or floral elements. Responsibility for the hired items passes to the client upon setup and remains until they are collected.
- **For how long will I have hire of the items?** I only offer items for full day hire however set up can be done the day prior depending on access to your chosen venue. Collection is typically arranged for the morning following your wedding, coordinated directly with your venue for a smooth pickup.
- **When do I have to pay the full amount?** A £100, £200 or £400 booking fee (depending on the total cost of booking) is required to secure your date which forms part of the total cost for hire. Final payment of outstanding monies due for the hire shall be paid no later than 3 months prior to the wedding. A payment reminder will be sent out by email shortly before the due date. If the final balance is not paid at least 3 months prior to the wedding then I will open up your date to my waiting list and you risk losing your booking if contact is not received and payment made. Non-payment by the final due date, with no communication, will be treated as a cancellation by the client
- **How is payment made?** I have a business bank account with Starling Bank. Payment can be made via bank transfer or by card using a payment link if you prefer to pay by card.
- **Can I pay in instalments?** Yes. Your initial payment will be your booking fee, then you can pay off your balance as and when is convenient for you, as long as the full balance is paid by the due date.

FAQs + Terms & Conditions Continued...

- **Cancellation Policy:** If you need to cancel your booking then any monies paid, minus the booking fee, will be refunded to you if you inform me a minimum of 3 months before the wedding.
- **What if I need to change my booking?** Any changes to your booking (e.g. switching items, changing venue, or altering your date) must be requested in writing and are subject to availability and approval. Significant changes may be treated as a new booking.
- **Can you set up items and then return later in the day to move them?** If decor is required to be moved between ceremony and reception spaces on the day, a room changeover fee will apply. This is to cover the additional time and travel involved and starts from £50.
- **Venue Access and Suitability:** It is the client's responsibility to ensure that the venue has adequate access, space, and facilities for all hired items. Wild Fern Weddings will not be held responsible if an item cannot be set up due to space limitations, ceiling height, access restrictions, or any other venue-related issue. No refund will be issued in such cases. Dimensions of decor is detailed in my brochure.
- **What happens if you (Wild Fern Weddings) cancel our booking?** In the extremely unlikely event that I am unable to provide your decor due to illness, accident, or another serious unforeseen circumstance, I will let you know as soon as possible and issue a full refund of all monies paid. I will also do my best to recommend a trusted alternative where possible.
- **Are any flowers used in the decor ours to keep?** Any bouquets you have ordered are yours to keep and enjoy after the wedding. However, all flowers and foliage used in your venue decor – including centrepieces, arches, and styling items – remain the property of Wild Fern Weddings and are hired to you for the day only. These items must not be taken home, given away, or disposed of unless agreed in advance.

Bouquets:

- **Are the bouquets made with fresh flowers?** I only use high-quality preserved and dried flowers in my bouquets. These are real flowers that have been carefully treated to maintain their beauty for much longer than fresh ones – so you can keep your bouquet as a lasting keepsake from your day. Plus, they're a more sustainable choice and much less prone to wilting or damage!
- **What if certain flowers or foliage aren't available for my bouquet/centrepieces?** All bouquets and centrepieces are made using high-quality preserved foliage and dried flowers. Due to the nature of these materials and the changing availability of stock, slight variations may occur. Every effort will be made to create your bouquet and centrepieces exactly as pictured or discussed during the design process. However, if certain stems are unavailable, suitable alternatives will be carefully chosen to maintain the same overall aesthetic and style. The final design will reflect the agreed look and feel, even if individual elements vary slightly.
- **How should I look after my bouquet?** Although quite robust, preserved and dried flowers should still be kept away from direct sunlight, moisture, and high humidity to help prevent fading or damage. Some types of preserved foliage can occasionally release a small amount of natural residue or preservation fluid, especially if there's a sudden change in temperature. This is a normal characteristic of preserved materials, but I recommend handling your bouquet with care to avoid any potential transfer onto clothing or fabrics. Once your bouquet is handed over, its care becomes your responsibility. Unfortunately, I'm unable to offer refunds or replacements for any damage that occurs due to storage, handling, or staining after collection or delivery.

On-the-day coordination:

- **Do you offer toastmaster duties as part of your on-the-day coordination service?** Wild Fern Weddings offers discreet, behind-the-scenes coordination to ensure your day runs smoothly. I do not act as a formal toastmaster or MC (Master of Ceremonies), but I will be there to guide guests, coordinate transitions, and liaise with your suppliers and venue team to keep things on track.

FAQs + Terms & Conditions Continued...

- **Will you help us plan the wedding and source suppliers?** On-the-day coordination includes oversight of the timeline, supplier liaison, decor setup and transitions, and general problem-solving on the day. It does not include planning or sourcing suppliers. Wild Fern Weddings is not responsible for the actions, delays, or non-performance of any third-party suppliers.
- **Do we meet before the wedding?** I will arrange either a face to face or zoom meeting roughly 1 month prior to your wedding. - **Does the 10 hours include your set up time of decor?** From arriving on site, my first 2 hours are allocated to setting up your decor and your 10 hours commences after this. Standard coverage is for up to 10 consecutive hours on the day. Additional hours may be added at £30/hour if pre-agreed only.
- **Do we need to feed you?** A hot meal and some water or soft drinks would be hugely appreciated! It helps keep my energy up so I can stay focused and support you throughout the day. Most venues are used to providing a supplier meal, and I'll always eat out of sight of your guests (usually while you're eating too, so I'm not needed).

Dimensions & Considerations

Love Lights - Each letter is 1.2m high by 60cm wide. Both set's of my love lights are battery powered.

Hannah Flower Wall & Sequin Wall - 2.4m x 2.4m. The frame used to support the walls is adjustable so if you ceiling is slightly lower than 2.4m then this won't be an issue.

Graze Wall - 2m x 1.2m. Around 50cm of space is required behind the Graze Wall to allow for the support frame.

Adeline Doors - Each door is 2.1m x 60cm. Around 50cm of space is required behind each door to allow for the support frame.

Moon Frame - 2m x 2m

Willow & Everly Archway - 2.4m x 2.4m

Eden Selfie Frame - 2.4m x 1.2m.

Plinths - Each plinth is 102cm x 40cm

Jupiter - Tallest: 180cm x 30cm. Smallest: 100cm x 30cm

Harmony - 2.4m x 1.7m. The base is 92cm deep. Allow for 46cm behind the main frame.

Oakley - 1.8m x 1.8m

Cleo - L-223H×190cmW, M-166H×140cmW,S-110H×92cmW

Freya - Allow for 10ft of height and 8ft of width.

Evie Canopy - With branches fully extended each tree is 3.1m high. The frame is 2.6m however, so if you ceiling is below 3m then the trees will still fit, however you won't get the full effect from the branches above the tree frame.

Layla Wall - H2.4m x W2.5m. Allow for 47cm behind the wall for support feet.
